



2- What is the climate of the region where you live?

This question can be answered according to the student's point of view, for example a student can say I live in Egypt and its climate is hot and dry in summer, mild and rainy in winter.

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3- Why is it coldest in the Polar Regions?

Because Earth is a sphere, the poles, at the top and bottom of Earth's sphere, receive the least sunlight of all, and therefore have a layer of ice year-round.

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4- How does the shape of Earth affect the climate of different regions?

The equator is at the widest surface of Earth, so the sun shines directly on it when Earth is facing the sun. Because Earth is a sphere, the surface curves as it moves away from the equator, and those areas receive less direct sunlight. The poles, at the top and bottom of Earth's sphere, receive the least sunlight of all, and therefore have a layer of ice year-round.

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5- Are you more likely to have a warm climate in Canada or in Mexico? Why?

The climate is warmer in Mexico because it is nearer to the equator than Canada, and more far from the poles than Canada.
